#### Where do we park once we arrive? Are parking passes issued?

NO on-campus parking is available on Friday, October 15, because this will be a workday for Georgetown staff and an appointment day for Medical Center patients. Guests are encouraged to take Metro and transfer to free Georgetown University shuttles (GUTS) at either Dupont Circle (Red Line) or Rosslyn (Blue/Orange Line). You may also take taxis to and from campus, and taxis are generally available at the Healy Gates and adjacent to the Leavey Conference Center entrance.

Street parking is extremely limited and the hourly limits are strictly enforced with tickets issued if not observed.

Saturday and Sunday: Guest parking will be available in the Southwest Quadrangle garage which can be accessed from the Georgetown University entrance on Canal Road.
